Chappels - World Partners, Mexico

Last month the Chappels celebrated 13 time in other jobs in addition to years of ministry in Mexico. The first three years were spent planting two churches. Since then they have been mentoring and training pastors throughout central Mexico. This month they will celebrate their 20th wedding anniversary! "It's hard to believe that we've now lived more than half of our married life in Mexico!"

Dan travels sometimes 10 - 12 hours to visit local pastors to train them as they teach their congregations. Most of these pastors continue to work fullpastoring their churches.

Life in Mexico has many dangers that we in Canada don't have to face. Driving conditions are often hazardous and roads occasionally get washed out as weather can be quite severe.

The Chapples are currently looking at moving to a new neighbourhood hoping for more safety than their current location. Please pray for their ongoing safety and God's blessing for fruitful work in bringing glory to God!



This week we'll be talking about when we hold onto grudges it affects everything we do. Do you have any friends that are holding grudges? Invite them out this week!


Wednesday, May 8 - Sorry Not Sorry
