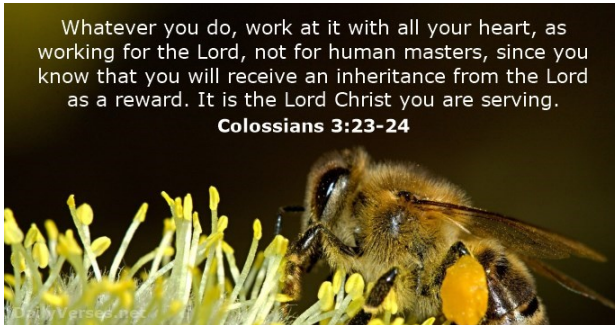

EMCC Assembly Report

"I see you" is a South African greeting meant to communicate. "I see you fully." It is an invitation into relationship. This was the theme of the Evangelical Missionary Church of Canada (EMCC) Assembly in Toronto, April 26-28, 2019. We gathered as delegates, friends and leader of EMCC to fully see each other, to see our purpose for our future.

Jesus spoke of being a good neighbour. We discussed what this meant going forward as a denomination through guest speakers, round table discussions and presentations by our president, Kervin Raugust, and board members.

We looked at what new things Jesus would have us do or follow. EMCC's ethos is: Following Jesus together. We discussed what that looks like moving forward. We looked at what we, as churches, could expect from our leadership and, in turn, what the board could expect from the church body.

The assembly began with workshops on Friday afternoon. I attended "Praying with Authority" where we learned about our authority for prayer, healing and prophetic prayer. After supper delegates participated in a discussion with Ryan Stockert about his film "End of Churchianity."

Saturday started with a presentation and discussion on World Partners – whether to continue as we are or change to a model of working with established groups and supporting them.

The business meeting, election of board members and financial review were held on Saturday afternoon, followed by a Q & A with the president and a round table discussion about what following Jesus together means.

The one thing I learned that was impressive – we are not a denomination built on separation or splitting. We have been built on mergers and growth. We look forward to continuing in that direction.
