Why do we sing?

If you really think about what we do every Sunday, it's pretty different. Singing is a very personal thing. So, why do we all gather together once a week and sing?

When you sing, you obey.

Colossians 3:16 Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts.

Look what the Psalms say about singing:

Psalms 5:11 "Let all who take refuge in you rejoice; let them ever sing for joy, and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may exult in you."

Psalms 9:2 "I will be glad and exult in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High."

Psalms 51:14 "Deliver me from blood guiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness."

Psalms 59:16 "I will sing of your strength; I will sing aloud of your steadfast love in the morning. For you have been to me a fortress and a refuge in the day of my distress."

Psalms 63:7 "For you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy. When you sing, you build up others."

When we do what the Bible says and sing together as a church family, we are hearing confessions of faith all around! We are hearing hundreds join with us and sing, "In Christ alone, my hope is found!" We are hearing hundreds of testimonies of faith all around us!

When you sing, you glorify God.

Chapple Family - Mexico



The Chapple family serve in Mexico, where they train and equip pastors by leading and implementing a training program

called SEAN (Seminario por Extension a las Naciones). We are very encouraged by the Chapples as we continue to support their work. Over the summer, the Chapples were in Canada on Home Ministry Assignment. They were delayed returning home to Mexico due to passport delays for their sons, but thankfully they returned home safely and without any difficulties. God was truly with them as they crossed borders and drove through 'gang-controlled' areas.

Upon returning to Puebla, they learned that violence had increased in towns around Puebla while they were gone. There have been many 'lynchings' taking place and the local people are fed up with the violence and have begun taking matters into their own

Colossians 3 and Ephesians 5 bring this out simply but powerfully, telling us to sing "to God" and "to the Lord" because He is the object of our praise. Ephesians 5:19 says, "singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart." It is to Him and about Him that we sing! Singing has a unique way of bringing your heart, soul, mind, and strength together to focus entirely and completely on God. In an age of distraction, singing grabs the attention of all our senses and focuses us on God.

Enthusiastically Wired

Advent has begun, a time where we celebrate the birth of hope, life, and love in the person of Jesus who came as a humble baby. As we read through the Christmas Narrative, which I hope you'll take time to do (Luke 1-2, Matt 1-2), we encounter some interesting people. Some are startled, some are quiet, some are seeking, some are encouraged... but there's a few who are enthusiastic. There are the shepherds who go with excitement into Bethlehem to find Jesus and tell everyone about Him. Anna is in the temple and meets baby Jesus and explodes with worship. Zechariah sees an angel and can't speak, but communicates as best as he can with enthusiasm that God is giving he and his wife Elizabeth a son in their old age. Then we see the wise men who come prepared to find the new born king with gifts of worship.

Our seventh spiritual pathway - ways we connect with God - in this series is that of an "enthusiast". These people connect with God through mystery and celebration. They express themselves in worship and outward displays of passion and enthusiasm. They wear their hearts, feelings, and love of God on their sleeves... sometimes literally. Quiet reflection is fine if you are an enthusiast, but it leads somewhere-celebration, experience, and supernatural encounters. If you are an enthusiast you probably read parts of



the Bible about dancing, miracles, parties, and worship and long to be there, and long to have these as a regular part of your spiritual life. There is a sense of action here, and a focus on what God is doing.

Keep it up - we need this more and more in the church. Lead the way with reckless abandon, but beware of chasing experiences rather than chasing God. Follow the example of the wise men. They saw the star - God was speaking their language - and they did something about it. After a long journey, a brush with a wicked king and crooked religious leaders they found Jesus... and they worshiped. May you do the same this Christmas Season. Don't be content with parties, services, and gatherings use these to journey to Jesus and enthusiastically worship Him.

Matthew 2:11 (ESV) And going into the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh.
