Lessons from a Plastic Tree

I have a yearly character building practice that happens in November – putting up the Christmas Tree. I have a love/hate relationship with this. I love our front room at Christmas time because the warm glow of the tree makes sitting with a coffee a bible and Jesus in the early morning hours really special. But to get there I have to wrestle with our tree.

We were given a pre-lit tree about 10 years ago and it's been a battle to keep it lit ever since. I've even cut off all of the attached lights that came with the tree since so few of them worked anymore, and I strung up other ones now. Hours of frustration finding burnt or missing bulbs sucks, and often threatens to ruin the whole mood of the day that I actually look forward to. This year was much better, but as I felt my frustration mounting, and as I knew God was speaking into my heart to learn patience again, a new thought came. What if this process, that doesn't ever seem to get much better, is supposed to be hard. I started to think of the many people I know going through struggles and about my own struggles and that maybe, just maybe, there are things in life that God allows to be hard for a reason. That on the other side of the struggle and difficulty there are deep things like joy, freedom, thankfulness, and spiritual maturity.

Missions Update

Peru 2020

We have been travelling to Peru for 15 years, serving in various short term missions projects. We have led medical teams into extremely remote areas, and have also participated in many other projects there. Many people from Country Hills have joined us over the years. We now feel that God is calling us to give for a longer period of time. We will be serving in Peru from January to April 2020 under the umbrella of Isaiah Projects

(www.isaiahprojects.com).

During the 4 months we will be working with several iProjects' ministries including La Buena Semilla (The Good Seed), a home for children deemed "at risk" by the government. https://www.isaiahprojects.com/puerto -maldonado-peru. The home is surrounded by a cacao plantation and Eric will be working with the farm manager to develop a 5-year strategic plan that will see the farm financially viable and able to sustain the running of the home. We will also be working in Trujillo and Pacasmayo with a young pastor, Auden Lujan, and the afterschool program run from the church here. Of course, we will be working back in Lima with the Equipo de Suenos team at many of the new churches in the outlying developments.

During our time in Peru we will be offering 4 - 3 day Family Ministry Conferences and will work with 12

couples at each conference to begin their training for family leadership in their churches and communities. There are several couples that we have been privileged to help train during our previous 3 years and they will be working with us in Lima. It is also our plan to offer evening study opportunities for other members of the churches and these will focus on The 5 Love Languages, The Five Languages of Apology (both by Dr. Gary Chapman), Boundaries (by Dr. Henry Cloud) and Eric will lead several sessions on financial management. Eric is currently working on an 8 week study on finances that will be utilized by the leadership team in Lima for ongoing training in the 15 churches served by Equipo de Suenos.

Also, while we are in Peru, there will be several other teams arriving, including a children's ministry team and a medical team, giving us the opportunity to serve in other ministry outside of our own.

We covet the prayers of our church family during this time of mission and ministry specifically for the growth, safety and health of both ourselves and those we go to serve. We know that God has many things to teach us as we step out in faith.
