This January there are a number of opportunities at Country Hills Church that can help you grow closer to God. The first is to take some time to **Fast.** Towards the end of the month will be starting three weeks of prayer and fasting (January 27 - February 16). During that time we will be having a three day food fast as a church family. If you can't fast from food maybe you'd like to pick something else to fast from. There will be some resources available at the back of church and on our web page to help you decide what you and your household might do. Beyond these three days I also encourage you and your whole household to fast from some other things that often distract us from focusing on Jesus and replace them with practices that do.

Another way you can deepen your walk with Jesus is to take the Hearing God Seminar. This is a six week course beginning January 17 at the church that will help you recognize, understand, and obey the voice of God. Many people at Country Hills have found this to be extremely helpful in their relationship with Jesus, and several have taken the course more than once. I encourage you to sign up as soon as you can.

My hope is that as we start a new year you'll start it off right by asking God to do the things in you that you can't do for yourself. As you do this in the new year, you might just discover a new you!

They facilitate three different programs; IMPACT, a two week program for cross cultural and ministry orientation, PLANTS, a two week language acquisition program and RE-VIEW, a five day debriefing program for missionaries returning from the field or desiring to process their mission experience.

This past October, two members of the Country Hills Missions Committee had the opportunity to sit in on one day of the IMPACT program. It was wonderful to see so many missionaries from different organizations all coming together to learn how best to serve the Kingdom of God. The students spend the two weeks getting to know each

other, attending workshops, attending unique cultural experiences and listening to experiences of people from other cultures or who work in different cultures.
