## New Year, New View

Happy New Year! With each new year comes a promise of endless possibilities and new opportunities. It's my prayer and my hope that you will encounter God in a fresh way this year. This is one of the reasons we are starting the Encountering God series in January. We want you to draw near to God, to follow Jesus in victory, and see God work through you in powerful ways. In order for this to happen some of us need a change in perspective - New Year, New View!

Fear of the LORD is the foundation of true knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline. Proverbs 1:7 (NLT)

This is one of the first lessons in the Book of Proverbs, but the word fear has often been misunderstood. A better understanding has more to do with respect than being afraid. Here's the thing... I think there are times we are afraid of God.
In his book "Empowering Missional Disciples," Bob Rognlien shares some reasons why he used to resist living more intentionally in the power and authority God gives us. It was mainly because of fear and control.

## People Helping People Follow Jesus

Afraid of doing the wrong thing, afraid that walking in authority might somehow seem like an abuse of spiritual power, and afraid to give up control to God. I resonated with this because I have some of the same fears and at times these fears have kept me from drawing near to God and obeying
when He speaks. How about you? Are you afraid of God or what drawing near to Him might change?
I want you to draw near to God instead of staying distant or afraid. During the Encountering God series we will learn about (and practice) hearing God, abiding in Christ, taking steps to freedom and victory, and inner healing. As you encounter God you will find that He loves you deeply and that His perfect love pushes away fear.

8 Taste and see that the LORD is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him! 9 (Reverently) Fear the LORD, you his godly people, for those who fear (worship \& adore) him will have all they need. 10 Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who trust in the LORD will lack no good thing. Psalm 34:8-10 NLT (words in brackets added)

Plan to attend the 4 week Encountering God teaching series on Sundays, and the accompanying Prayer Gathering, Small Group and/or Seminar. I think it will change your relationship with God to one that is intimate and deep, and help you live an abundant life.

Praise God that we are seeing that the SEAN classes are having an impact on our pastors lives and ministries. Several pastors have begun to use the material to equip new leaders to help them start new Bible studies and missions (that is what they call an outreach/or church plant). Pray that we will continue to encourage, equip and support these pastors and lay leaders to continue in their studies and in their ministries.

Pray for Mexico as the violence and unrest in the country is reaching very high levels. Many of our pastors are concerned for their own safety, as there has been an increase in threats from groups requiring that they pay "protection" money. We have been evaluating the situation together with our mission leaders and feel that for the time being we can remain in Mexico but if things continue to degrade we may have to leave the country in the future.
