Active Faith

If you're passionate about a cause or issue, something that is deeply important to you and impacts the world we live in you probably can't Luke 4:18-19 (NLT) 18 "The Spirit of understand why others don't feel it too. Maybe you have posted articles, gone to fundraisers, joined organizations, or even been involved in promotional or protest based events to get the word out. Regardless of what the "issue" is, you feel it deeply and you want others to feel it deeply too. Well I've got good news - God designed you that way. In fact this is one of the very ways He invites you to relate to Him.

A few months ago I started sharing some of the sacred pathways God builds into us to relate to Him. You can take the survey for yourself here northpoint.org/care/pathways to help identify how you tend to connect with God best.

This particular pathway is known as "Activists." You express your love for His world through God confrontation, and you tend to fight for Godly principles and values. encourage you to see this as a form of worship, to align yourself with topics and issues that beat close to the heart of God. Jesus is our example here, because He confronted with love, and early on in His ministry He read the following passage from Isaiah to

proclaim that He had come to fulfill this prophecy.

the LORD is upon me, for he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim that captives will be released, that the blind will see, that the oppressed will be set free, 19 and that the time of the LORD's favor has come."

Peter was like this too - feisty and deep. God transformed him through Jesus from a guy who was willing to fight with a sword to protect those he loved, to a man willing to stand up and preach to thousands with tenderhearted boldness.

You have a place and a purpose in the body of Christ, and without "activists" our evangelism, social justice, and how we engage our changing culture with truth and grace would suffer. This is an act of worship, so worship God through more than just songs and work towards shifting the church and the world in line with God's heart.


